CITY PROJECTS

Wilson Park Rehabilitation will commence in October 1st. Contract awarded to Consolidated Engineering. Improvements include new playground equipment, park lighting, BBQ grills, small and large dog parks and planned skate park.

SB2 General Planning Grant: Storm Drain Waste Water Master Plans Update awarded to Bennett Engineering; **Zoning Code Update** awarded to Interwest Consultant Group.

Caltrans Sustainable Communities Planning Grant: Consultants have been interviewed for the Main Street Redesign & Revitalization Plan. Study to include developing a pedestrian bridge from Main Street to the waterfront.

Property owners are reminded to register all rental properties with the City Rental Housing Inspection Program.

Department of Waste Resources (DWR) award the Delta Region Geologic Hazard Abatement District (DRGHAD) in the amount of \$895,343. Grant program funds will augment staffing by funding a Resilience officer to develop local initiatives, mitigate flood damage and outreach for preparedness and recovery.

The City will be advertising for a consultant for the Isleton Emergency Flood Plan funded by the Department of Water Resources. This grant also allows the City to acquire equipment for preparedness and flood mitigation. Equipment will include hand tools, light plants, emergency power packs, siren, electronic emergency board, pumps and flood flight materials.
