CITY PROJECTS

The City has received funding for the renovation of Wilson Park. The improvements include refurbish the baseball field, parking lot, park area and playground equipment. Cost estimate is \$178,000. City staff will schedule and announce meetings for community input early summer.

The City has been awarded a grant to study to develop a boat launch at its water front.

The City is working with a government contractor to bring improved internet service to Isleton. This contract is working under the Federal program focused on improving rural internet service.
